#### **Bus Transportation 22-23**

School Bus online registration for 2022-23 school year will open on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, registration will run till August 7th. From August 8 to October 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will be building routes and adjusting runs and as a result bus registration will be closed during that time and will re-open Monday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>. All students need to register or re-register every year, if you don't register by the deadline you will have to wait till October before your student can ride the bus. We had a new automated registration system implemented last year, if you're a returning rider you would have been sent a login and password, back when you originally registered to use to securely log into our site.
