# Covid Notice

The province has announced that they will continue to trace Covid exposures in schools. Exposures can occur at three levels: Level 1, limited to close

contacts of the case and their contacts may receive either self-isolation or self-monitor letters; Level 2 there was close contact suspected or confirmed between the case and the entire class; Level 3 there is transmission between the class. Parents will be notified via email as exposures happen that impact their child.
