Graduation Requirements (ENG)



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Students require a minimum of **80 credits** to graduate. Of these 80 credits:

- **At least 16 credits** must be **Grade 12 level**, including a required **Language Arts 12, Career Life Connections** and one **Indigenous Peoples** course in English or Social studies.
- At least **28 credits** must be **elective course credits**.
- **52 credits** are required from the following:
 - **Career-Life Education** (4 credits), and **Career-Life Connections** (4 credits)
 - **Physical and Health Education 10** (4 credits)
 - **Science 10** (4 credits), and a **Science 11** or **12** (4 credits)
 - **Social Studies 10** (4 credits), and a **Social Studies 11** or **12** (4 credits)
 - A **Math 10** (4 credits), and a **Math 11** or **12** (4 credits)
 - A **Language Arts 10, 11** and a required **12** (12 credits total)
 - An **Arts Education 10, 11, or 12** or an **Applied Design, Skills and Technologies 10, 11, or 12** (4 credits total)

Graduation Requirements Cont.



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In addition, students must also complete **three graduation assessments**:

- Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment
- Grade 10 Literacy Assessment
- Grade 12 Literacy Assessment

Grad Requirements: French Immersion



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To graduate with both diplomas, French Immersion students must meet the graduation requirements for the **Dogwood Diploma** and, of these **80 credits**, they must earn:

- **At least 16 credits at the Grade 12 level** (including a Français langue seconde-immersion course at the Grade 12 level)
- **Français langue seconde-immersion 10** (4 credits)
- **Français langue seconde-immersion 11** (4 credits)
- **Français langue seconde-immersion 12** (4 credits)
- **At least 12 credits in Grade 10, 11, or 12 courses that are in French** with at least 4 of these credits at the Grade 11 or 12 level.

In addition, students must also complete **four graduation assessments plus**

- **Évaluation de littératie de la 12 année**

Scholarships



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- **District Scholarships**

- 100-hour projects completed in areas of interest in passion (fine arts, community service, drafting, trades, etc.)
- More to come in October...

- **Abbotsford Community Foundation**

- These are available to any graduating student; one application can get you up to 10 submissions (academic, athletics, minor sports associations, fine arts, policing, trades, etc)
- More to come in January – Counsellor Michelle Nyberg is your contact

- **University Entrance and Major Community Awards**
